DRESS BLACK CONCERT ATTIRE INFORMATION

As the season changes from fall to spring we will move into a new time of the band year; concert season. While the marching season has many weeks and events to go, we must also turn our minds to our Concert Band Music Performances Assessments and Spring Concert, as well as the multiple performances of our concert and jazz bands during the winter and spring.

In the past, marching band uniforms were worn for concert band, but these uniforms are neither constructed for concert band nor appropriate. As we strive to improve our band in all respects the concert band, percussion ensemble and jazz bands will continue to wear appropriate concert attire.

Students will be responsible for ordering appropriate "Dress Black" for participation. For boys a basic black tuxedo will be needed. Boys may wear their marching shoes or purchase black tuxedo shoes locally. For girls a floor length black princess gown will be needed. All dresses are custom made and girls will be responsible for the purchase of their own shoes but they must meet certain requirements.

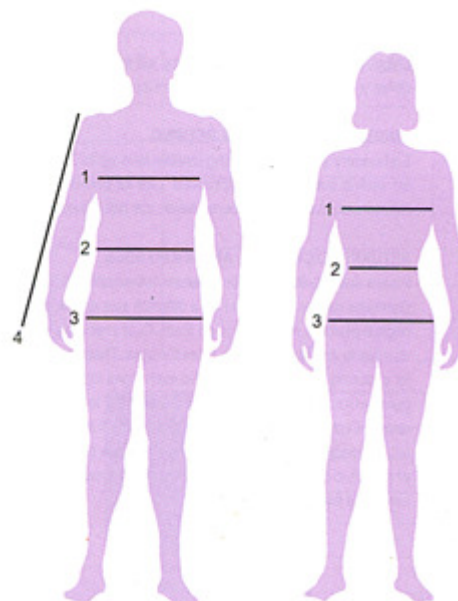

How to Take Measurements

- BUST:** Women measure around the fullest part of the bust and around the back over the bra line.
CHEST: Men measure under arms, across chest.
- WAIST:** Measure around smallest part of natural waist.
- HIPS:** Measure around the fullest part of the hips.
- SLEEVE LENGTH:** Men's tuxedo shirts only. Bend elbow. Measure from center of back of neck, across shoulder, around point of elbow to wrist bone.



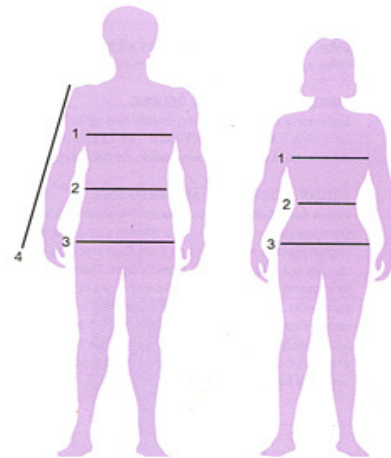

How to Take Measurements

- BUST:** Women measure around the fullest part of the bust and around the back over the bra line.
CHEST: Men measure under arms, across chest.
- WAIST:** Measure around smallest part of natural waist.
- HIPS:** Measure around the fullest part of the hips.
- SLEEVE LENGTH:** Men's tuxedo shirts only. Bend elbow. Measure from center of back of neck, across shoulder, around point of elbow to wrist bone.



GUIDELINES FOR GIRLS SHOES

- Shoes must be plain black. No designs
- NO MORE THAN a two inch heel.
- Shoes must have a back.
- Shoes must be closed toe.

IMPORTANT CONSIDERATIONS WHEN MEASURING FOR YOUR GOWN

You must be dressed in only a good fitting bra (not a sports bra) and underwear. Avoid measuring yourself! Please have your mother, relative or professional tailor take your measurements.

Wrap measuring tape around your body snugly, but don't pull it tight! Don't suck in your stomach. The better you measure, the better your dress will fit, but always plan on alterations!

- **Never guess your size**
- Don't assume you wear your size in everyday clothes; special occasion and wedding dresses run small.
- Your bra size is not your bust measurement.
- Focus on fit not size; it's only a number on the label no one will see.
- Plan on alterations for a perfect fit; everyone needs them.
- Don't assume you can let out a dress; it's often impossible.
- You can't take in a dress more than one size without changing the design.
- Select undergarments in colors near your skin tone to avoid showing through your dress.
