



## “BAND DEPARTMENT ANNUAL SPRING CONCERT”

Please come out and support your child at the Treasure Coast High Schools Band's 5<sup>th</sup> annual Spring Concert. It will be held on **March 25<sup>th</sup> 7:00 p.m. at the Treasure Coast High School Auditorium**. Listed below are some facts and details that you and your child need to be aware of:

### REPORTING TIME / ATTENDANCE:

- The concert is *FREE* and open to the public. (*so bring an uncle or the lady next door*)
- The music begins at 7:00 p.m. Your child must report to Treasure Coast at 5:00 p.m. (*as we must have time to set up, warm up & take care of any problems that may occur*)
- Your child WILL NOT be allowed to perform if he/she is late.

### ATTIRE:

- **The mandatory performance attire for the Symphonic and Titan Jazz performers is:**

Black gowns for young ladies and tuxedos for gentlemen. Boys may wear their marching shoes or purchase black tuxedos shoes locally. Boys are expected to have black socks & shirts are expected to be crisp white. Young ladies are expected to wear ONE PAIR of performance appropriate ear studs. No ear rings for gentlemen are allowed. Young ladies with any piercings other than in their ears are expected to have them removed while in their gown.

### GUIDELINES FOR GIRLS SHOES

- Shoes must be plain black. No designs
  - NO MORE THAN a two inch heel.
  - Shoes must have a back.
  - Shoes must be closed toe.
- Students will not be allowed to perform with the band if they fail to adhere to the dress requirements.

- Wednesday March 23<sup>rd</sup> – Titan Jazz Band (2 pm – 5 pm)
- Thursday March 25<sup>th</sup> – TCHS Symphonic Band (2 pm – 5 pm)

### INFORMATION FOR SENIORS:

- Senior band students are to be in place at 5:30 pm in their black concert attire for the yearly composite picture.

**OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION:**

- This performance will constitute a major portion of your child's grade for the semester therefore attendance is mandatory.
- Students that do not attend rehearsals will not be allowed to perform at the concert on Friday.
- Students are expected to report on time so that rehearsals will end on time.
